- What capabilities are required and what potential does it represent?

In the third session of our Women's Technology and Business Program which is organised by AustCham's Women in Business Network, Darrin Webb from Telstra will run you through about Digital Transformation.

Digital transformation is essential for future competitiveness and is a major issue for every country and every industry. As part of its global research series, Telstra commissioned the Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU) to produce the Connecting Capabilities report, which includes the first Asian Digital Transformation Index, in order to explore the potential for digital transformation within 11 key Asian markets. The Index compared the capabilities of these markets under three key categories including digital infrastructure, human capital, and industry connectedness.
