Hong Kong has achieved impressive progress as Asia's world city, which is reflected in various international rankings covering a range of areas.

Economy and business

- **World No.1 freest economy** for the past 24 years (US-based Heritage Foundation)
- **World No.1 for economic freedom** since 1996 (Canada-based Fraser Institute)
- **World No.2 competitive economy** (Swiss-based International Institute for Management Development (IMD): World Competitiveness Yearbook 2018)
- **World No.3 business environment** (Legatum Institute: Legatum Prosperity Index 2017)
- **World No.5 Ease of Doing Business** (World Bank: Doing Business Report published in October 2017)
