WEEKLY UPDATE

Dear Members and Friends,

Last weekend AustCham Chair Josephine Orgill, Director Jason Chang and myself travelled to Shanghai to attend a reception with Australian Prime Minister, Anthony Albanese, the Minister for Trade and Tourism, Senator Don Farrell and key government and business leaders. This visit was the first by an Australian leader since 2016.

Throughout his <u>speech</u>, the Prime Minister highlighted the extraordinary growth of China's economy over the last 25 years and the history of Australia and China's trade cooperation. Praising the Australian and Chinese business community Albanese vowed to work constructively with China. He also met with China's President Xi Jinping at the Great Hall in Beijing the next day to further discuss ties between China and Australia and their highly complementary economies.

Hosted by Tourism Australia, the event was attended by around 400 business and government representatives, with AustCham leadership and our members given the opportunity to meet with the Prime Minister. We were thrilled to connect with our members from Hong Kong and across mainland China at the event, including MTR, MA Financial, EMR
Capital, ANZ, CBA, Minter Ellison, Qantas, King & Wood Mallesons, Victoria Government, Trade and Investment Queensland, Investment NSW and more. The Prime Minister's trip also marked the 50th anniversary of Gough Whitlam's historic visit to China. Our thanks to Austrade, DFAT, Tourism Australia and our Chamber's from across China for their support and collaboration.

In other exciting news, the Chamber hosted its third Melbourne Cup Luncheon event at the Royal Hong Kong Yacht Club on Tuesday with Title Sponsor ANZ. The Hong Kong Climate Action Plan 2050 was released in October 2021.
